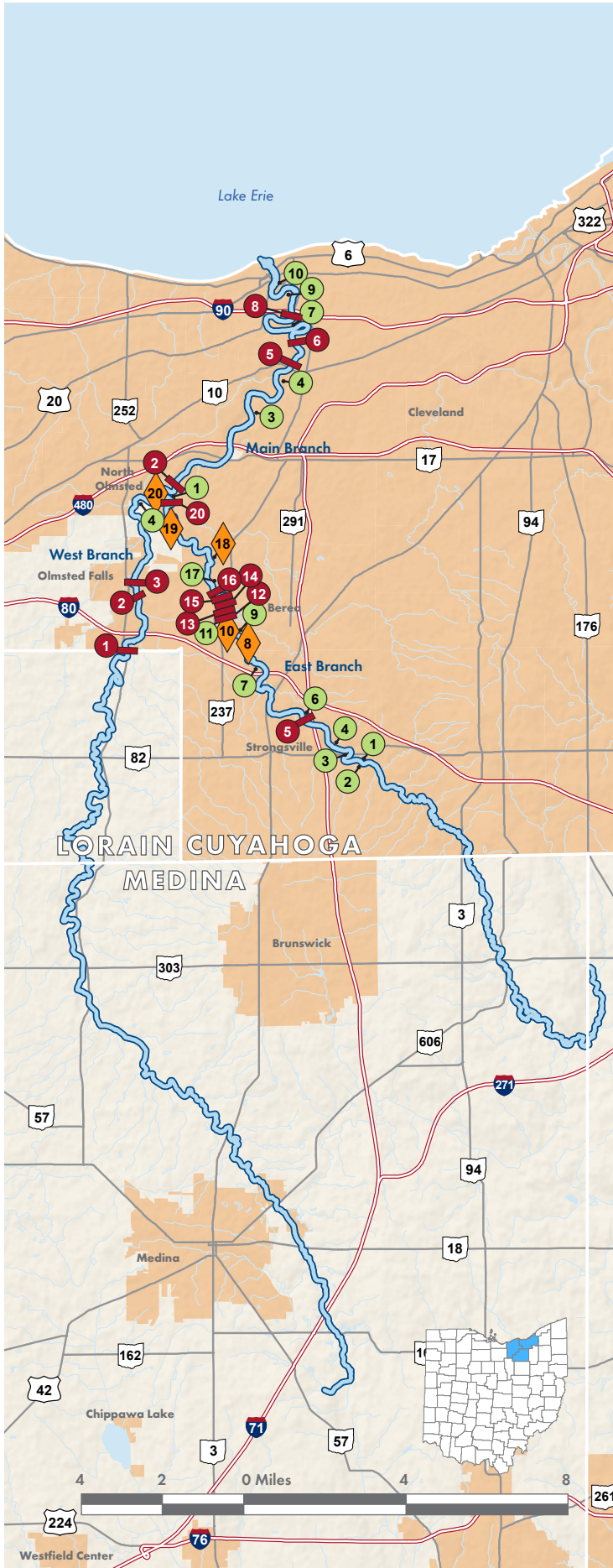

1	Cedar Point Picnic Area off Cedar Point Rd. east of North Olmsted, access river left	41.40656 -81.88770	
2	DAM—downstream of Valley Pkwy. bridge in Rocky River Reservation. Bridle Trail, a nearly grade level concrete road, crosses the stream in three tiers here. Very dangerous in high water. Portage river right or left if necessary	41.40760 -81.88193	
3	North Mastick Picnic Area downstream of Puritas Ave. bridge in Fairview Park, access river left	41.44008 -81.84500	
4	Little Met Golf Course just upstream of old Lorain Rd. bridge off of Valley Pkwy., access river right	41.45032 -81.82794	
5	DAM—about 3/4 miles downstream of Lorain Rd./St. Rt. 10 bridge northeast of Fairview Park, portage river right	41.45968 -81.82163	
6	DAM—about 1 mile downstream of previous dam and Valley Pkwy. bridge, portage river right or left	41.46656 -81.82099	
7	Rocky River Reservation at end of Hogsback Ln. on Park Dr. in southeast Rocky River, access river right	41.46525 -81.82763

9	Metropolitan Park Dr. access at Eastland Rd. in Berea upstream of Baldwin Lake, access river left	41.35213 -81.84638	
10	HAZARD—old interurban line bridge supports could contain strainers/log jams, proceed with caution or portage river left	41.35618 -81.85015	
11	Between Wallace and Baldwin Lakes on Cleveland Metro Park Dr. in Berea, access river left	41.36004 -81.85674	
12	DAM AND FALLS—at Baldwin Lake just above the N. Quarry Ln. bridge in Berea, portage river left or right	41.36305 -81.85549	
13	DAM—first dam at water treatment plant in Berea 750 feet downstream of N. Quarry Ln. bridge, portage river left	41.36532 -81.85638

16	DAM—350 feet downstream of Center St. bridge in Berea, portage river left	41.36896 -81.85416	
17	W. Bagley Rd. bridge in Berea. MANDATORY TAKEOUT BEFORE SERIES OF FALLS. LACK OF PORTAGE AND ACCESS IN GORGE AND ONE DAM; GORGE SHOULD NOT BE RUN	41.37267 -81.86228	
18	FALLS—SERIES OF FALLS JUST DOWNSTREAM FROM BAGLEY RD. BRIDGE IN BERA. ABSOLUTELY NO PORTAGE IN GORGE, SHOULD NOT BE RUN	41.37594 -81.86471	
19	FORD—Valley Pkwy. ford upstream of Spafford Rd. bridge east of North Olmsted, portage river left or right	41.39600 -81.88290	
20	DAM—with two stair-steps about 1/2 mile downstream of Spafford Rd. east of North Olmsted; bad portage, must portage further upstream river left	41.40016 -81.88377	
21	FORD—at mouth of the east branch off Cedar Point Rd. on Valley Pkwy., portage river left or right	41.40598 -81.88621	

West Branch

1	DAM—and river gauge at Sprague Rd./St. Rt. 252 bridge in Westview, must portage at least 100 yards upstream river left	41.35046 -81.90325	
2	DAM—200 yards below Bagley Rd. bridge in Olmsted Falls, portage river right before Bagley Rd. bridge, portage area flooded at high water and is dangerous	41.37447 -81.90026	
3	DAM—above Water St. bridge in Olmsted Falls, portage river right	41.37767 -81.89855	
4	Lewis Rd. bridge southeast of North Olmsted, roadside access river left	41.40462 -81.89300
